## Who Is Streaming?

Everyone who wants to make money, expand their business or save money.







## Encode

Decision to make: Hardware or Software?

•What's your budget?

- What do you have already?
- Who will receive your stream?









## Transmit

•Getting your stream to the Internet can be simple...

- ... or very difficult.
- Firewalls can be a problem in hotels
- Make sure you have adequate bandwidth
- Have a reliable signal. DO NOT RELY ON WiFi!
- •Use a hardwired connection where at all possible
- Test before, during, and after your stream
- •Wireless may be used in some cases.



## Distribute

## Ideally, use a content delivery network (CDN)

A CDN takes your stream and redistributes it to many

- A CDN can be free with ads or paid with no ads
- An advanced CDN is called an Online Video Platform (OVP)
- •OVPs are a type of cloud service

### You can stream directly from your encoder IF

You are simply going point-to-point

- You have very few viewers
- You have ample bandwidth

### Great things about web streaming

You can reach a lot of people anywhere

Can be free with advertising

Can make money through advertising or VOD

Powerful way to build a brand

Save money on travel and venue

Can be performed from multiple devices

#### Not-so-great things about web streaming

Expensive if not ad supported

Can be complicated to set up

Requires a fast and reliable Internet connection

It's not two-way
